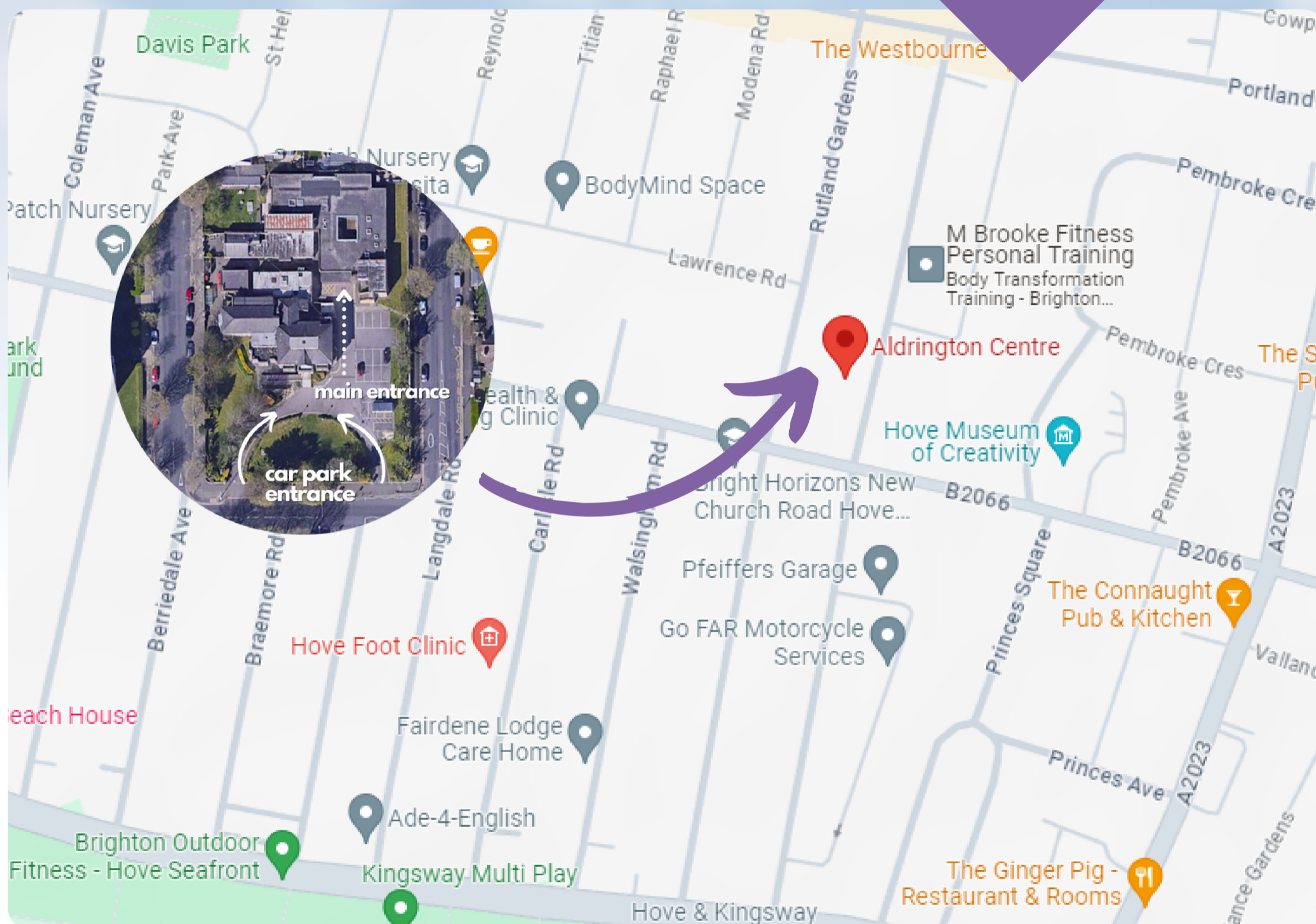


ALDRINGTON CENTRE:

**ALDRINGTON CENTRE,
HOUSE AND ANNEX**
35 New Church Road
Hove
BN3 4AG



LOCATION:

- The Aldrington Centre has its entrance on New Church Road, between Westbourne Gardens and Rutland Gardens. There are two buildings on the site, Aldrington House (a Victorian building) and the Aldrington Centre, which is situated on the right-hand side of Aldrington House.

Please do not attend your appointment if you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19.

MOBILITY ACCESS:

- **ALDRINGTON CENTRE**
 - There is level access into the building. All of the rooms are accessible on one level. Disabled toilets have been installed.
- **ALDRINGTON ANNEX**
 - There is level access into the building and all rooms are on one level.
 - This building is **unsuitable** for wheelchair users.

- If you have a hearing impairment that will be affected by background noise then please contact our admin team to rebook you into a different venue (brightonwellbeing@spft.nhs.uk; 0300 002 0060).

PARKING:

- There is a small carpark on site which is first come first served. If the carpark is full, there is some free parking very nearby on Lawrence Road. Otherwise, it's metered on-street parking - approximately £1 per hour.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

- It is on the 1, 1A and 6 bus routes. The number 49 stops a 5 min walk away on Sackville Road. For full details on Brighton & Hove buses please visit - <http://www.buses.co.uk>

ACCESS TO THE CENTRE:

- After 5:30pm there is no reception cover at the Aldrington Centre. As a result, if your appointment starts at or after this time please try and get to the appointment ten minutes early to avoid any difficulty entering the building.
