

# **LOCATION**:

- If you take a look at the site map above, the East Brighton Mental Health Centre can be located on the site of the Brighton General Hospital.
- The hospital itself is next to Freshfield Road, between Elm Grove and Pankhurst Avenue.
- If you follow Elm Grove, off Lewes Road, the hospital will come up on the right.

#### **PLEASE BE AWARE:**

- The reception at this location <u>does not open</u> until 08.30am
  - If your appointment is due to start before this time please just wait outside as your clinician will collect you at the time of your session.
- If you Google this location you need to search for 'East Brighton Mental Health Centre' and NOT the 'Community Mental Health Centre' as this will show you the wrong venue.

Please do not attend your appointment if you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19.

#### **MOBILITY ACCESS:**

- The building has a ramp to the front door and disabled toilets.
- We use rooms on the first floor, so if you have any mobility restrictions, please contact the Wellbeing team on 0300 002 0060 for us to arrange the use of a ground floor room.
- There is a lift, but it is not suitable for wheelchairs; only walking aids.

# **PARKING**:

• The car park is often full by 9am. Some free parking is available on Elm Grove & Pankhurst Avenue. Pankhurst Avenue is the best choice if there are any mobility issues.

### **PUBLIC TRANSPORT:**

- Local bus services stop outside the front, rear and side of the hospital (routes 2, 2A, 21, 22, 37, 37B and 84).
- The number 2, 2A and 21 all stop on level ground and close to the hospital.

- The nearest train station to the hospital is Brighton Station.
- From outside the station you can catch a bus (see details above) or get a taxi from the rank at the back of the station.
