

## **LOCATION:**

- The Youth Advice Centre has a colourful front with big letters that say YAC and YMCA on the entrance.
- It a short walk from Trafalgar Street, towards the sea front, and is placed between an opticians and a dentist.

Please do not attend your appointment if you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19.

## **MOBILITY ACCESS:**

- The Centre and reception is accessible and is all on one level.
- There is one room that is accessible for wheel chair users, however the toilet is on the upper floor which is not accessible.
- All other rooms in the building are also on the upper floors and so are inaccessible to anyone with mobility difficulties.

## **PARKING**:

- Parking is very difficult, so if you can, come by bus, taxi, train or walk.
- If you have to come by car please allow extra time to find a parking space.
- There is no on-site parking available to patients using the Youth Advice Centre.

## **PUBLIC TRANSPORT:**

- The 5, 5A, 17, 270 and 271 all stop at St Peter's Church and then there is a short walk to the Youth Advice Centre.
- The Centre is also a 10 minute walk from Brighton Station and a 15 minute walk from London Road Station.
